### OUR MISSION STATEMENT:

"Sharing the Love & Hope of God" From the Pastor's Desk Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen. September is here again and summer is over (officially September 21) and fall is here now. So, it's time for pumpkin spice everything, apple things, corn stalks, and all things fall.

During the month of September God has blessed us in several ways, be it through our outreach programs or through our Sunday Worship Services. Do you still remember the sermon on the Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-28)? This story illustrates God's boundless love, compassion, and immediate forgiveness for those who repent and return to Him.

The other message during this month of September was on 2 Timothy 2: 1-13 in which Apostle Paul encourages Timothy, to fully accept his calling despite the suffering and hardship that come with this life. The letter also reminds Timothy to maintain faith and hope in Jesus' resurrection and raise faithful leaders who will teach the Good News about Jesus. This scripture passage uses the metaphors of a soldier, an athlete, and a farmer to illustrate the need for focus, discipline, and hard work in ministry, emphasizing that true reward comes from pleasing Christ and not from worldly distractions. Friends, each one of us is invited to be

strong in the Lord and to put our hands on the deck communicating the Good News of Jesus Christ. Just like Paul to Timothy, we too will be recognized for our work during the end of time.

Each one of us has a place in our congregation to share our spiritual gifts, so, come knock on the Church Office door and tell me what gifts God is telling you to share with the congregation. We need volunteers in many areas of the life of the Church. Be it serving in a ministry of our church, or on a committee, there is enough space to accommodate your spiritual gifts.

I am also inviting those interested in joining a Church membership class to learn more about how to be a member of this congregation. This class starts the second week of October, so get hold of Ronda to register. In the month of October, we have a stewardship sermon series to share with the congregation how to faithfully manage and use the resources God has entrusted in us, including time, talents, money, and other gifts. This series inspires faithful living, encourages generous giving, and promotes wise resource management, fostering a culture of gratitude and responsibility within the church community.

On Sunday October 19 during worship our congregation is going to observe Laity Sunday. This Laity Sunday is celebrated the third Sunday of October. It is a time to



If anyone could handle this assignment-it's him. Everything aligned to save my boys life and get the best care years in advance. I can see it clear as day. Does it suck sometimes? Yeah. It's hard to see your child's life change so much just by falling in a bathroom from standing position (we assume) and hitting his head just right. My kid has done a lot more dangerous/stupid stuff that could have ended up this way, but just a fall?! Make it make sense?! And then not knowing how/ why? It's hard. This is my raw- late nightdifficult moments, yet still so grateful. God's my strength right now. This is my "journaling" - documenting his journey here so I can look back in a year and say- look how far we've come!! (Honestly- I can say that just within 5 If you made it this far... please keep us in your prayers. They're clearly helping. We thank you for

everything!! Night y'all!
